Summary MRC-Holland Foundation activities Quarter 1, 2016.

Activities of the MRC-Holland foundation have expanded rapidly in the last months. Total expenditure in the first three months of 2016 was EUR 1.015.955,-. This is a rapid increase as compared to our expenses in 2014 (complete year; EUR 1 million), and 2015 (complete year; EUR 2.0 million).

Support for "Wilde Ganzen" and "Wings of Support" has been discontinued as we decided to reduce our indirect support activities.

Projects in Gambia:

In The Gambia, we focus on building new government schools and renovation of existing schools. Incidentally we provide support for clinics, agriculture projects etc.

In Q1 we increased our workforce in Gambia with mr. Baboucarr Suwareh. Mr. Suwareh retired recently as Director of Education for District 2 of Gambia. Together with Henriette Sonko, who is working part-time for the MRC-Holland Foundation and is part-time the representative of the Dutch government in Gambia, mr. Suwareh will visit schools, discuss projects with the school management, local representatives, the Gambian government and contractors.

Next to mrs. Sonko and mr. Suwareh, we employ mr. Jarjo who is architect and building supervisor, and mrs. Jarmilla Hofman who visits schools for smaller projects. Finally we collaborate with many Dutch foundations who provide support for specific Gambian villages already for many years.

At this moment, we expect to finish building at least 141 new class rooms in 2016. In Q2 2016, we expect to sign contracts with contractors for building at least 59 classrooms. Some of these might also be finished before the end of 2016. For future years we hope to finish more than 200 new class rooms / year.

JIBOROH BASIE CYCLE SCHOOL The School is a government owned school which was up graded in 2003. Thre are four permanent buildings of three classrooms each (12 classrooms). Onle of these 12 classrooms is the school has a roll of 1,340 pupils with a teaching staff of 45 teachers. Some members of the foundation visites the school last year with their Gombian counter-part, Mr. Kalifa Kantel of Siffoe. Durig the visit a meeting was held at the school with the Healmaster Series teachers and some members of the school Management Committee and the following Concerns were raised:-1. CLASSROOMS: - The role of the school is increasing every day, and as at now there are 25 classes : Grade One - 3 classes, Grade two-4 classes, Grade three - 2 classes, Grade faur - 3 classes Grade fine - 2 classes, Grade Six - 2 classes, and in the upper sector: Grade seven-3 classes, Grade eight - 3 classes and Gracle nine - 3 classes making a total of 25 classes when there are only 11 classrooms. All these Il classrooms are occupied by the lower sector in the morning and 5 classes of the lower sector has to come in the After-noon to join the upper sector, and even that 3 classes are houses in the the school beelt for Small children. The school will therefore need 16 more classrooms and if this is possible them it would again
